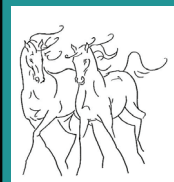


FLEX-MD

Equestrian surfaces are safer with additives!

- ◆ Flex-MD is ground from the 'punching' after molded medical gaskets are removed from large sheets of material
- ◆ Flex-MD additive is used in Dressage, Jumping, Pleasure and Flat work arenas
- ◆ Blends very well with the Pos-A-Trac felt additive (Pos-A-Trac is used to increase moisture and consistency)
- ◆ Adds spring or "cush" to footing by allowing 'room' for the all important air-pocket
- ◆ Easily harrows for daily maintenance
- ◆ Prolongs life of the sand by reducing friction of sand particles
- ◆ The flat nature of Flex-MD can be used to advantage in arenas where a binding affect may be needed—consult with your footing representative
- ◆ A stable footing bed builds your horse's confidence and willingness to work
- ◆ Helps prevent stress on legs and tendons
- ◆ Long-term stability; typically, rubber will out last sand particles by many years
- ◆ Flex-MD does not rot
- ◆ Average application rate of Flex-MD is 1 to 1-1/2 lbs per square foot
- ◆ Flex-MD is contained in 4x4x4 super sacks at an approximate weight of 1550 lbs each
